During his twenty-five years of campus law enforcement experience, he distinguished himself as one of the earliest practitioners of behavioral threat assessment in higher education and has over sixteen years experience in case management and team training. He also served as a crisis negotiation team leader. He has trained threat assessment teams from both the private and public sectors and assists SIGMA clients in managing difficult cases. He frequently presents at conferences and to professional organizations on the topics of behavioral threat assessment and management, workplace violence, stalking and clinical office safety. Mr. Wilson is a long-time member of the Association of Threat Assessment Professionals (ATAP), and was one of the founding members and past President of the Arizona ATAP Chapter. He was the recipient of ATAP's Presidential Recognition Award in 2009 for his work on the National Board of Directors where he served for four years. Mr. Wilson also serves on the ASIS International School Safety and Security Council and is a member of the ASIS Arizona Chapter executive board. He is a member of the Arizona Coalition against Domestic Violence and served on the East Valley Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team. Mr. Wilson is a Certified Protection Professional (CPP), one of only 5,500 security practitioners world-wide who hold the board certified credential from ASIS International, which recognizes demonstrated knowledge and competencies across a broad range of security management domains. Prior to beginning his law enforcement career Mr. Wilson was an Infantry Officer in the United Army serving both in Europe and the United States. He holds a B.A. in Political Science from American University and a Masters in Public Administration from Arizona State University.
