She is a member of the Association of Threat Assessment Professionals (ATAP) and is active in ATAP's Texas chapters. Before joining SIGMA, Mrs. Marble served for over 26 years with the U.S. Secret Service, most recently as the Special Agent in Charge for the U.S. Secret Service Houston Field Office where she managed the Secret Service offices in Houston and Austin, Texas, as well as Mexico City. She has extensive experience conducting as well as supervising threat assessment and protective intelligence investigations on high-profile public officials and public figures. She has also served as a senior supervisor on the Secret Service Presidential Protective Division and held the position of Director, Threat Policy Coordination/U.S. Secret Service Liaison on the National Security Council Counterterrorism office. While serving on the National Security Council, Mrs. Marble was responsible for coordinating the multi-agency response to threats directed at the U.S. Olympic team and U.S. delegation during the Athens Summer Olympics in 2004. Her background includes more than 26 years of experience managing political, integrity and security risks in complex and hostile environments. Mrs. Marble earned her Bachelor's degree in Political Science from the University of Houston in 1987 and was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in January, 2011.
